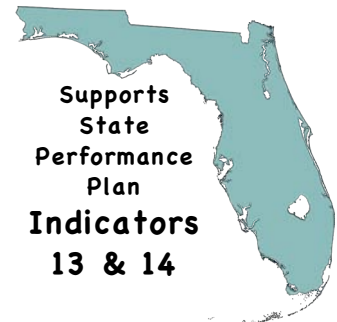

"Appropriate measurable postsecondary goals based upon age appropriate transition assessments related to **training, education, employment, and, where appropriate, independent living skills**"  
Regulated under the 2004 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act

The following assessments are available for students in secondary classrooms:

- Keiser University Independent Living Skills Assessment (KUILSA)\*
- ONET Ability Profiler\*\*
- ONET Interest Profiler\*
- ONET Work Importance Locator
- Pictorial Career Interest Inventory\*



\* Available for students with limited reading skills and complex communication needs.

\*\*Requires 6<sup>th</sup> grade reading level. However, accommodations can be made to assess students when appropriate.

Assessments can be given in both face-to-face and virtual platforms by KUMDC staff.

Assessment results may assist teachers in writing measurable post-secondary goals to support key areas of transition.
