The Keiser University Multidisciplinary Center (KUMDC) is one of six regional Florida Diagnostic and Learning Resources System (FDLRS) Multidisciplinary Centers providing a range of services including screenings, assessments for children and youth at risk for or who have been identified as having complex medical, educational, emotional or behavioral problems and other risk factors for poor educational/academic outcomes. KUMDC also provides mentoring, consultations, case conferences technical assistance, and training.

KUMDC can assist teachers, staff, administrators, and families with Functional Behavior Assessments, technical assistance, consultations and training including the use of behavior analysis to reduce problem behaviors and increase adaptive behaviors.
