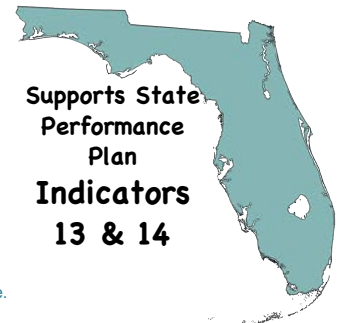

The following assessments are available for students in secondary classrooms:

- Keiser University Independent Living Skills Assessment (KUILSA)*
- ONET Ability Profiler**
- ONET Interest Profiler*
- ONET Work Importance Locator
- Pictorial Career Interest Inventory*



*Available for students with limited reading skills and complex communication needs.

**Requires 6th grade reading level. However, accommodations can be made to assess students when appropriate.

Assessments can be given in both face-to-face and virtual platforms by KUMDC staff.

Assessment results may assist teachers in writing measurable post-secondary goals to support key areas of transition.
